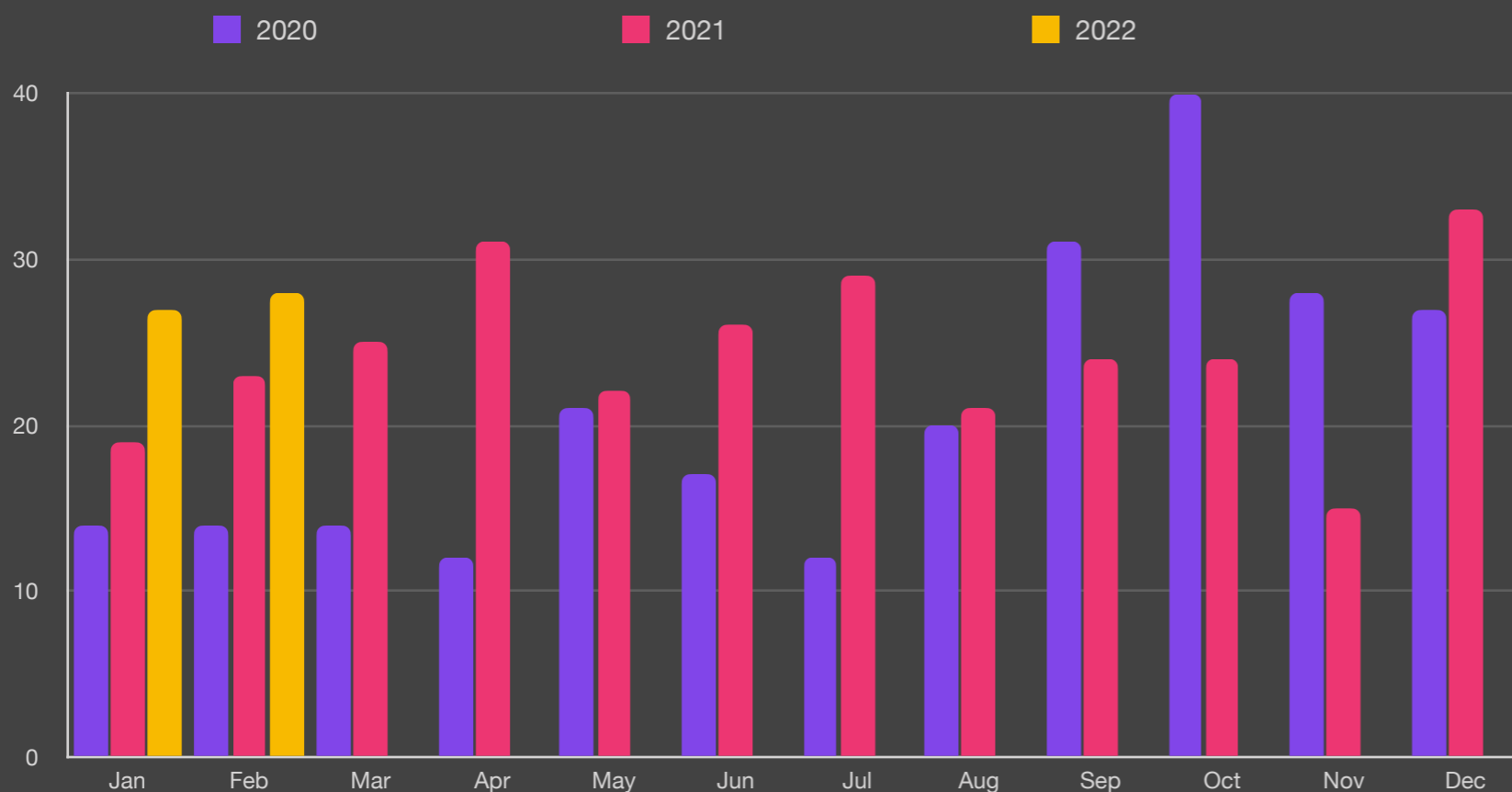


February 2022

We recorded 28 ransomware attacks this month, with almost half occurring outside of the United States. Notable incidents included an attack on the San Francisco 49ers' during Super Bowl weekend and an attack on KP Snacks, a well-known UK snack food manufacturer.

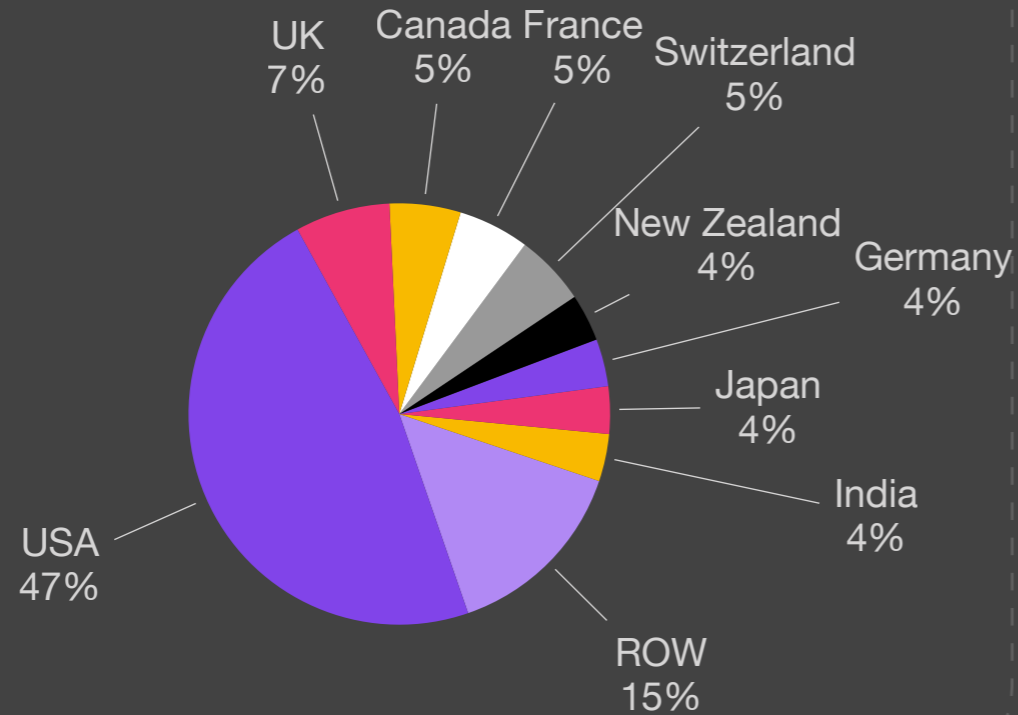

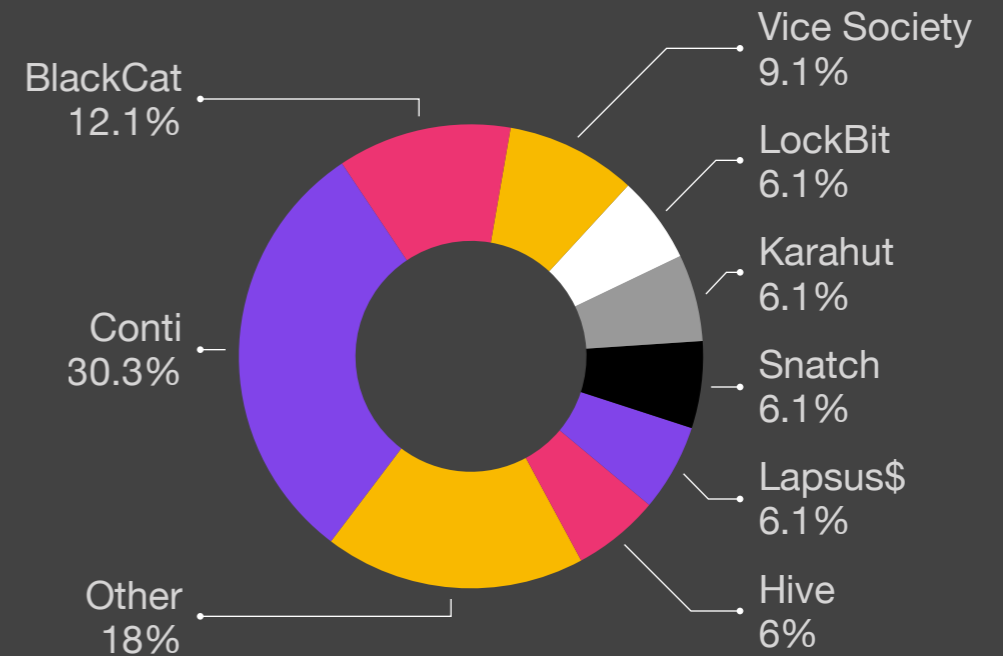

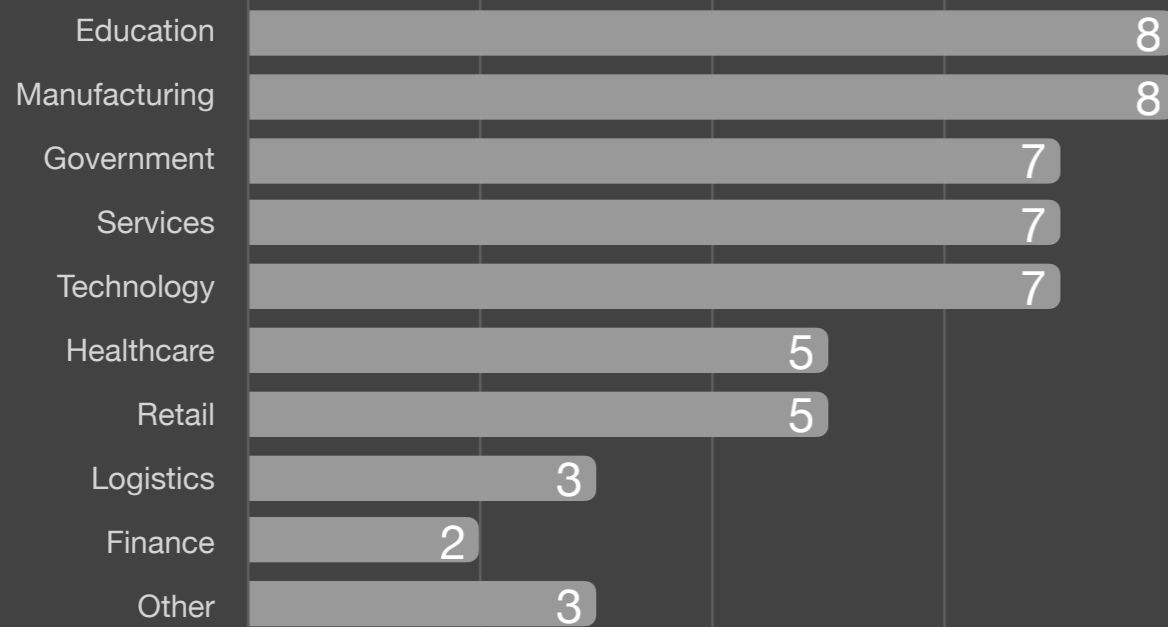
Ransomware by Country



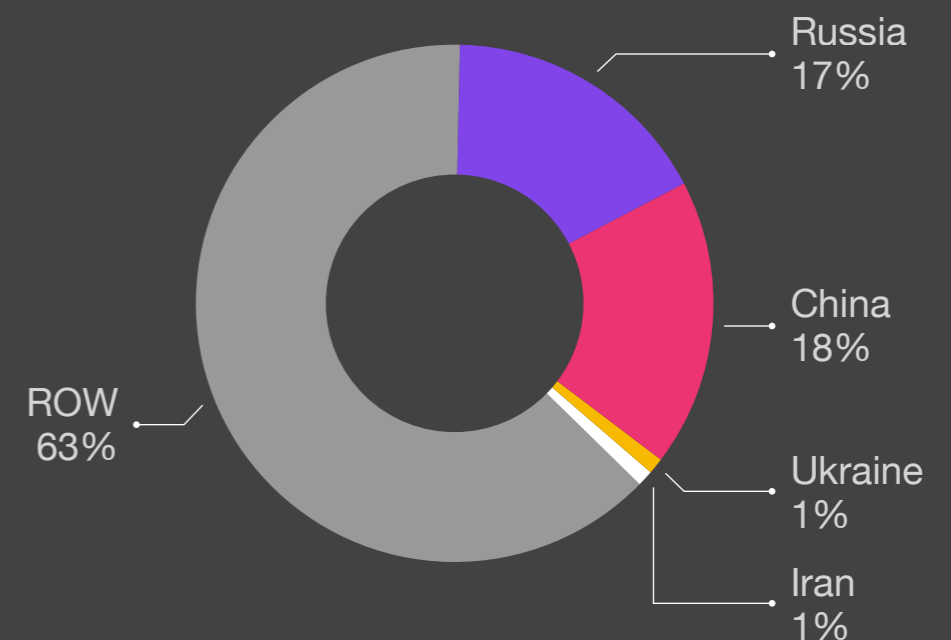
Ransomware by Variant



Ransomware by Industry

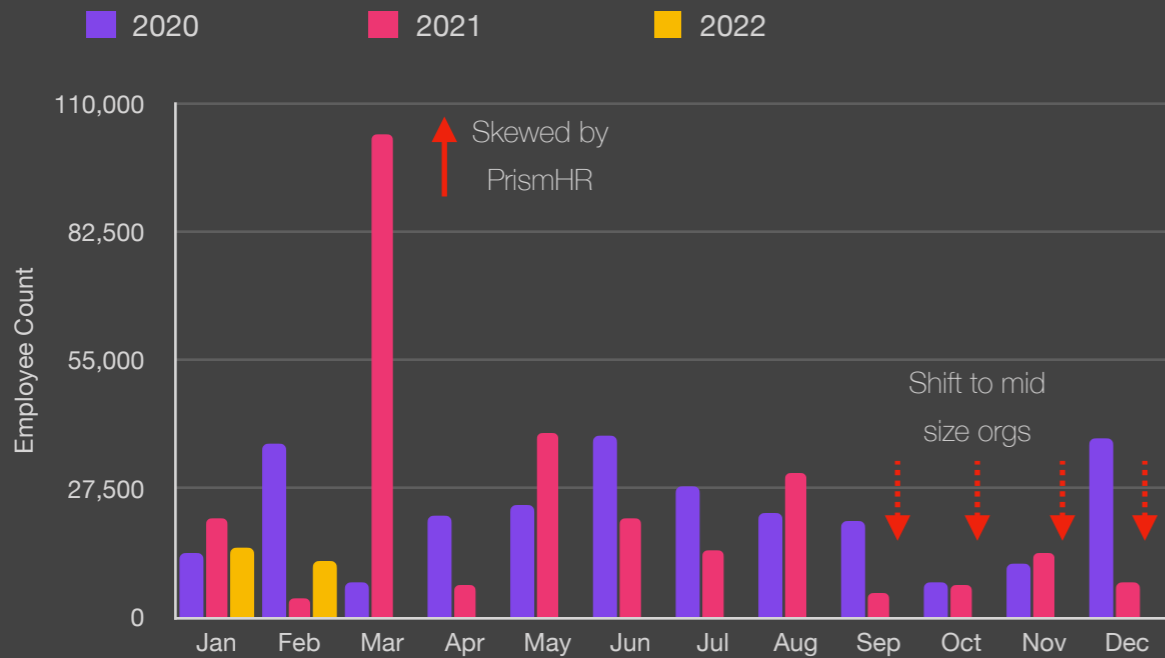


Ransomware Exfiltration Country

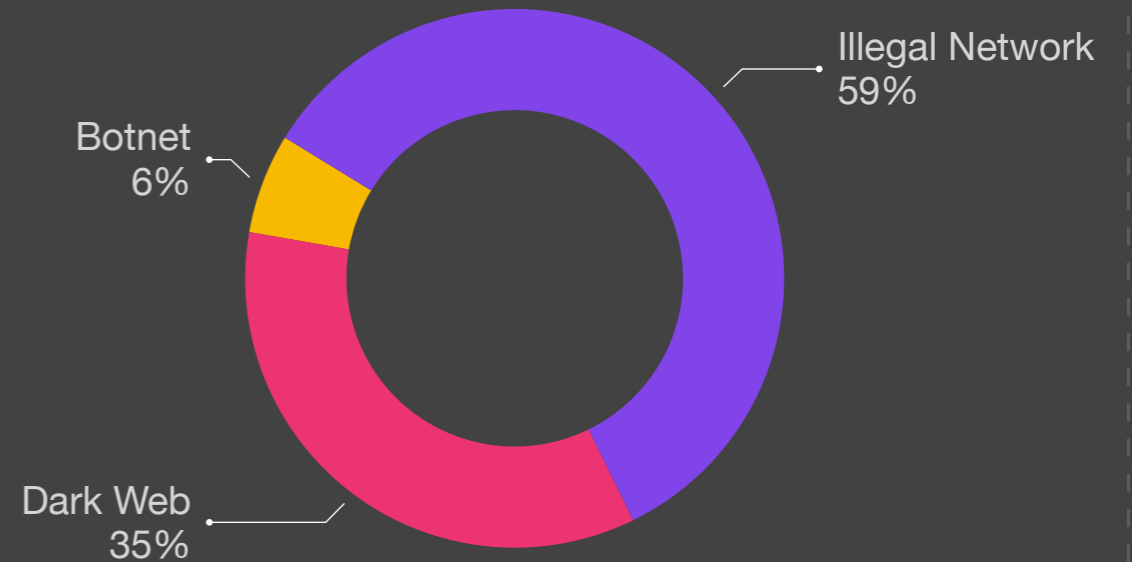




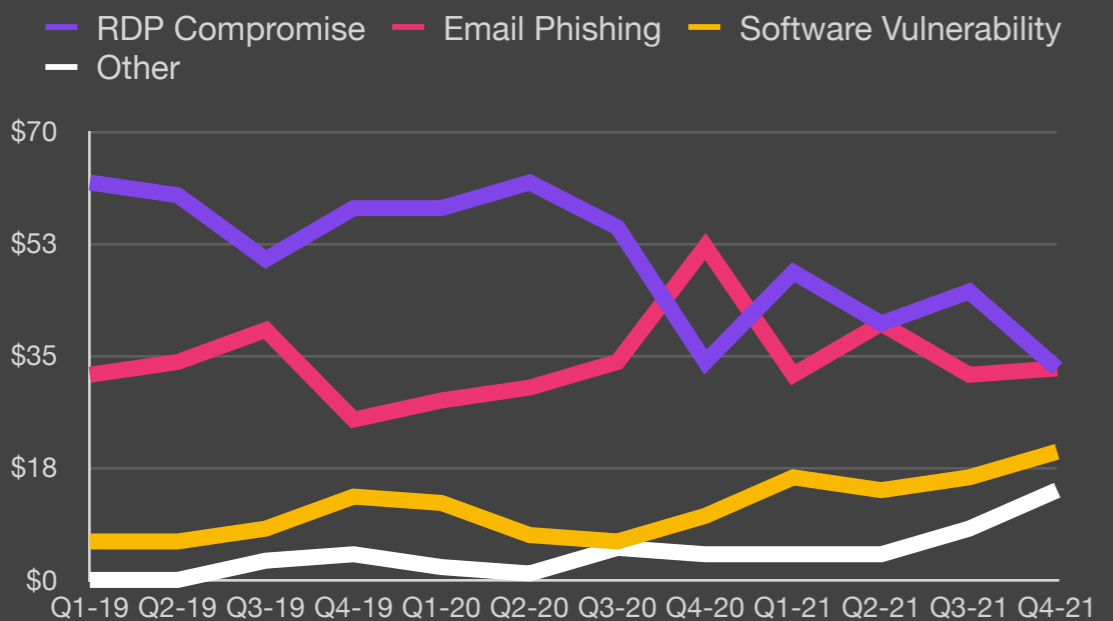
Size of Organization

Methodology
